What does this role contribute to the Company?

As Projects and Continuous Improvement Manger, you will take ownership of Project Management driving a Continuous Improvement ethos to match our innovative approach to how we work. What we will ask of you:

- Act as change agent at all levels of the organization regarding continuous improvement culture and its alignment with the organisation's vision, values, and objectives.
- Support the development and implementation of continuous improvement techniques.
- Review and define the company's Project management structures and methodology.
- Coordinate the collection of observations, ideas and solutions and implement project administration and management.
- Develop and establish Project Teams within the organization to support project implementation.
- Oversee all aspects of each project which will be running simultaneously.
- Set deadlines based on the requirements of the projects, assign responsibilities to the relevant internal teams and external partners, and monitor and summarise progress of each project during a weekly Project meeting with the Senior Leadership Team.
- Assist in the definition of project scope and objectives, involving all relevant stake holders and ensuring technical feasibility.
- Execute tracking action plans, analysis programs and oversee progress.
- Develop a detailed plan to monitor and track progress than will form the basis of Project Update meetings and ensure effective flow of information to all stakeholders.
- Perform risk management to minimise project risks.
- Create and maintain comprehensive project documentation and plans to be shared with other team members.
- Meet budgetary objectives and adjust project constraints based on financial analysis.
- Coordination and completion of Product Development projects on within budget.
- Drive Improvement Projects (yield, process capability, etc.) to maximize efficiency and predictability.
- Analyse process capabilities across the company and facilitate selection of specific lean production projects.
- Develop reports of overall Continuous Improvement activities including accomplishments, participation, projected activities, and anticipated needs.
- Coordinate follow-up meetings for every event/Project to ensure work is completed and improvements sustained.

- At least 4 years proven experience in a project management or business improvement management role.
- Extensive Experience of end-to-end project management across a variety of different types of complex projects.
- Have a methodical approach to implementation planning, project risk management, resource prioritisation, and problem resolution and be able to demonstrate how you have applied this.
- Ability to demonstrate commerciality and credibility to act as business partner across all areas such as Sales/Marketing/Engineering/Operations etc.
- Previous experience of using a wide range of IT platforms including but not limited to MS Office.
- Excellent communication skills both verbal and writing.
- Good problem-solving skills and ability to thrive under pressure.
- Excellent organisational skills including attention to detail and multi-tasking skills.
- Ability to show initiative and drive to manage multi agile projects to completion.
- Proven experience as a strong business partner with commercial awareness to influence across teams including Sales, Marketing, E-Commerce, R&D, Engineering and Operations.
